Recruitment Process

1

Initial Communication

The RICC provides interested recruiters with the Day Zero and Day One recruitment brochure, student profiles, and key timelines. Organizations may also initiate contact by emailing the committee directly to share recruitment opportunities.

2

Pre-Placement Talks

For better clarity, recruiters may engage with interested students through virtual or in-person pre-placement talks to provide information about the firm's practice areas, work environment, expectations, and growth prospects.

3

Pre-Interview Process

Recruiters have the flexibility to adopt their preferred screening methods, such as CV shortlisting, aptitude tests, written assignments, or group discussions.

4

Interview

Recruiters shall thereafter share a list of shortlisted candidates for the interview process. Recruiters have the option to carry out the entire selection process either offline or online, with complete assistance from the committee.

5

Intimation of Offer

Recruiters are expected to communicate all job offer(s) to students exclusively through the placement cell. Recruiters are also encouraged to provide the RICC with a list of waitlisted students in case the initially shortlisted students are unable to take up an offer.

Beyond litigation, the initiative facilitates the direct admission of underprivileged children into private institutions under Section 12(1)(c) of the Act, striving to make quality education a tangible reality for local communities.



Smart Village Initiative

Through the Smart Village Initiative, LAAC maintains sustained engagement with the village of Surpura, creating a scalable model for rural empowerment. This project has successfully established a Community Library, a dedicated Skill & Craft Development Centre for women—branded as Shilpajeevika—and a fully functional Computer Lab. By focusing on digital literacy and vocational training, the initiative fosters self-reliance and progress, with ongoing efforts now directed toward replicating this holistic development framework in other rural regions across Jodhpur.
